



Accident Investigator Training

Overview

Hazards exist in all workplaces and in most situations there are effective measures in place to control them. However, incidents and accidents do occasionally occur – indicating that some of these controls are not as effective as they should be.

Learning lessons from accidents and incidents is vital to reduce losses to your organisation. This workshop draws on the guidance published by the Health & Safety Executive (HSE) in their accident investigation guidance (HSG245) to develop foundation skills in accident investigation.

Who should attend?

This workshop has been developed for anyone whose role requires them to carry out investigations into accidents and incidents.

This is a two day workshop.
