

Risk Assessor Training

Overview

Risk assessment is a critical activity to help protect workers and others who come into contact with your organisation's activities, as well as complying with the law. An effective risk assessment will focus on the risks that really matter and provide the starting point for controlling them.

This workshop presents the principles of risk assessment to be applied by delegates on a series of case studies relevant to your industry.

Who should attend?

The workshop has been designed for anyone who needs to carry out qualitative risk assessments in their workplace.

Duration

This is a half day workshop. It can be extended to a full day to allow the delegates to carry out a range of real risk assessments, with coaching and feedback being given on their practice

What will you learn?

This workshop provides an introduction to the principles of risk assessment and then uses a series of case studies for participants to practise these techniques. The workshop covers:

- identifying hazards;
- developing and using severity and likelihood criteria;
- risk tolerability;
- risk controls;
- assessing suitable controls;
- introduction to dynamic risk assessment;
- recording risk assessments.

Delegates will receive a risk assessor handbook as part of the workshop to help them recall risk assessment techniques, typical hazards and control measures when they carry out their risk assessments.
