

Senior Accident Investigator Training

Overview

Serious accidents and incidents require a range of specialist structured techniques to make sure that the underlying causes are identified - factors that have the potential to cause further accidents elsewhere in the organisation. This workshop presents several root cause analysis techniques to be applied by delegates on a detailed case study.

Who should attend?

The workshop has been designed for senior managers and safety professionals who may need to investigate serious accidents and incidents effectively.

- change analysis;
- barrier analysis;
- Five Whys;
- narrative chronologies;
- timelines;
- time-person grids;
- fishbone analysis;
- event and causal factor charting, and;
- writing an investigation report in plain English.

Delegates will receive an investigator handbook as part of the workshop to help them recall investigation techniques when they carry out their first investigation.
